Pledge of allegiance

Guest speaker: Dawn LaVanway- Gave an updated County wide report.

Motion by L. Franckowiak to approve minutes. Supported by M. Franckowiak.

Pam and Lori attended a meeting with the township Auditor Dan Smith and he recommended that both Pam and Lori have a QuickBooks accounting system so each of them could do their duties and also be able to compare files and reconcile each of their accounts jointly which would provide an extra security for the township banking files.

Supervisor (Martin) sent an email stating that two different petitions were dropped off at his house.

Petition 1- for a street light to be installed at the intersection of 131 and Manglos rd. Reason stated for this new street light- It is hard to see at night.

Petition 2- for the seasonal section of Manglos rd. to be upgraded and lift the seasonal road restrictions. Reason stated for the lifting of season rd restriction- so local farmers could use so they don't have to be on main highway.

The petition was briefly discussed and then tabled until next month when a full board would be present.
